Dear District Customer,

The 2025 irrigation season is quickly approaching, and fortunately for BVID, Collins Lake began spilling on February 3, 2025 which assures that BVID should have plenty of water to serve through the 2025 irrigation season. BVID staff are currently working on several capital improvement projects which will result in increased water delivery efficiency and water savings. We are continuing construction on the Sicard Flat Pipeline Upgrade project, which is funded entirely by grant dollars and when complete, is expected to save approximately 3,000-acre feet of water per year in Collins Lake. We are also making upgrades to the Pumpline Canal, as well as upsizing culverts under Loma Rica Road. BVID has also received over \$2.8 million in grant funds to replace the Hydroelectric Generator at Virginia Ranch Dam.

Despite a wet winter, the Browns Valley Irrigation District still asks that everyone continue to practice conservation as we go into the 2025 irrigation season. As we have observed in recent years, the weather in California is extremely unpredictable and we never know when we will be right back into another drought cycle. Thankfully, the carryover in the reservoir has pulled us through in the past.

In previous years, when everyone has prioritized conservation despite historically low supplies, the District has been able to successfully fulfill demand. We ask that everyone continue their best efforts and remain mindful toward efficient use. Please do not allow your ponds to spill or allow water to leave your property.

2025 Irrigation Season

As always, the beginning of the 2025 irrigation season is dependent on weather conditions. In April, the Board of Directors will begin discussing the season schedule at each Board meeting. Please monitor the District website at www.bvid.org, as well as our Facebook page, for updates.

To save on postage costs, the District will continue to mail invoices bi-monthly, and payments are due on **April 30th, June 30th and August 31st**. There will be a 5% discount for customers that pay their bill in full by April 30th.

****An account will be deemed delinquent if payment is not received by the 30th day of the month in which the payment is due. A delinquency charge will be added to any Water Service bill that becomes delinquent and the charge will continue to accrue until the delinquent balance is paid in full. The delinquency charge assessed will be one and one-half percent per month (18% per annum) on the past due balance of the account.**
