# **STAFF ACTIVITIES**

Collins Lake continues to spill at approximately 154 cfs and we are releasing an additional 276 cfs through the powerhouse. The weather remains cool and wet, and it is projected to stay cool and wet through the first week of April.

The Administrative Services Manager continues to work on the 2023 Billing, which will be mailed out to customers at the end of March and into early April. The Technical Services Manager continues to

work on the RES-BCT billing, Sicard Pipeline easements as well as the 2023 Annexation and BVID fiber project at Collins Lake.

The Manager and Operations Manager have been reviewing the 2022 DSSMR, and the Manager has been working with Yuba Water and the IRWMP team on the application for the Hydroelectric Efficiency Improvement Incentives program as well as the contract with CEI for the LLA at the BVID property.

#### **CURRENT PROJECTS**

#### **Groundwater Substitution Transfer**

There will not be a transfer in 2023, due to the exceptionally wet conditions.

# **Conserved Water Transfer**

Option payment billing to Dudley Ridge and Santa Clara Valley were sent out, and there is interest from Dudley Ridge in pursuing the CWT. The CWT will depend on conditions in the Delta.

# **Sicard Flat Pipeline**

The US Bureau of Reclamation Environmental team sent the concurrence letter to SHPO for review on March 6, 2023 for the Sicard Flat Pipeline Upgrade project. If the SHPO does not have any comments, the District should receive NEPA approval in April.
