STAFF ACTIVITIES

With the end of the year rapidly approaching, the Administrative Services Manager has been working on closing out 2023 and continues to work on the 2024 Budget.

The Technical Services Manager continues to work on the Sicard Flat Pipeline project easements with the UC, wetland mapping and permits with Marcus Bole and the 2023 Annexation.

The General Manager has been coordinating with FERC and the Consultant on the District's Part 12D inspection; reviewing the 2023 EAP to submit to FERC; and working the Yuba County Surveyor and the District's legal on the Lot Line Adjustment and surplus land resolution.

On Monday, December 4, 2023 the General Manager and Operations Manager gave a tour of Virginia Ranch Dam to five Yuba Water Agency employees.

CURRENT PROJECTS

Sicard Flat Pipeline

Fusion and prep of Phase 4 began on October 23, 2023 and continued through the end of October. Phase 4 fusion began again this week and will continue as weather allows. As of today, the crew has fused and installed approximately 3.5 miles of pipe.

BVID Property

The survey work for the LLA was completed on April 25 and CEI submitted a draft map for District review. The map has been reviewed by the County Surveyor and final documents have been sent to Cranmer Engineering for review prior to recordation. The Surplus Land Act exemption is being reviewed by BVID's legal team and the resolution should be presented at the next Board meeting.

Upper District

The Sicard Pipeline crew continues to make progress on the lower end of the project. The crew has had some delays caused by the small amount of rain and scheduling issues with the fusion company. Construction is still on track to complete the fusion of 9800 feet of pipe consisting of 7400 feet of 16" and 2400 feet of 18" HDPE and should be completed early January.

Trenching for the Fiber Optic extension at Collins Lake started on November 6, 2023 and as of today, the trenching is complete, and conduit is in the ground. Fiber cable will be pulled into place and the overhead line to the powerhouse will be completed as weather permits.
